ENROLMENT INFORMATION

Eastern Hutt School has an enrolment policy in place. The scheme means that all children who live within the home zone have automatic right of entry to the school. All those who live out of the zone will be subject to the enrolment scheme legislation. Details of these are included in the pack.

Please complete all sections of the Enrolment Form and return it with a **copy of your child's Birth Certificate or passport including current visa** to school.

Our school donation is currently as follows:

1 or 2 children	\$275 per child
3 rd child	\$200
4 children or more	\$750 annually

It is not compulsory that you pay this donation, however the funds from all donations are used to purchase extra resources, digital devices for students, and teachers for Music, PE and Sport. These all help to enhance the learning programmes offered for your child. We also have an Activity Related donation of \$70.00 or \$75.00. This is payable for the whole year to cover the cost of all trips and cultural events.

Following on from a school wide study on conservation of the environment, the school had a very successful major focus on reducing the amount of non re-usable plastic being brought into the school. We strongly discourage the use of glad wrap, foil wrappers and chippie bags. Our aim is to encourage our students and families to develop the habit of avoiding the use of non re-usable plastic. Please find alternatives for your child's lunch e.g. a plastic lunchbox with compartments so food does not need to be wrapped or use paper wrapping or put food in re-usable clip bags which can be recycled for a week. Homemade muesli bars or biscuits do not need to be wrapped – please consider this as a very good option. We also encourage you to provide a healthy variety of food for lunches and that children have **only water** in their drink bottles.
